- Access pass to campus Cloud Services:
 - My Sac State, Email, SacCT, Printing, Wireless Access, personal webpage, etc.
- Create/Verify Sac State Account @ mysaclink.csus.edu
- Passwords expire after 1 Year
- Reset/Change password, set up security questions @ password.csus.edu

 - Google Docs


SAC STATE CLOUD SERVICES

FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE


- Direct Link to semester exam schedule




